- Hog Purchase Deadline
- Money Due: September 15th
- All Hogs must be in the barn by November 1st
- State Validation: \$15 per tag, Deadline September 15th
- If you want extra tags you must buy them now.

If you are looking for your animal:

- MUST have ONE year of swine showing experience.
- Have the means to transport hog to the barn.
- Must have Ag teacher approval
- Current health papers required before moving into the barn.

- Dark wave Only
- Age hog to buy: July 1st to August 1st born

Purchasing

Denton County Pigs:

- Terminal Show
- Preferred Gilts Only
- Breeds accepted: Duroc, Hampshire, Yorkshire, OPB, Light Cross, Dark Cross
- Age hog to buy: July 1st to August 1st born
- Cost \$500-\$1000

If wanting a barrow cost is \$1200 -\$1500

(This is due to the hogs being that same age as hogs needed for Houston)

- It is the responsibility of the student and their family to contact the vet for your animal.
- The Ag teacher will schedule the castration with the vet.

Clinic Schedule

Biosecurity Plan

- Isolation:
 - 1 week of bucket and brush time
- Cleaning and Disinfecting
 - Items
 - Animals: Wash in and wash out when leaving and re-entering the barn
- Minimize exposure:
 - Must utilize foot bath in front of walk through doors - Student leader refill foot bath
- Antibiotic upon arrival in the barn each time - Per Dr. Williams
- Medicated injected watering system - Per Dr. Williams
- Must use specific shavings listed: Champion Shavings or Snowflake Shavings
 - We are working on locating these shavings

Swine Barn Rules and Procedures

- Chore chart
- Clean pens daily
 - Green, yellow, red cards to indicate cleanliness of pen and warnings
- Pigs must be fed twice a day
 - By 8am and after 5 pm
- Tack room must stay tidy and feed barrels closed
- No trash anywhere in the barn at any time - No exceptions
- Must scoop pig poop from walkway to and from arena and in the arena.
- Use carts and wheelbarrows to haul feed and shavings into the barn from parking lot.
- Do not prop a door open for any reason

 - Hooflex (200 lbs or anytime with cracks in the hoofs)
- Show whip
 - Weaver 36" dressage whip (good stiff whip)
